

General Notes:

- Below are instructions for each song. Please read the notes about which songs have specific parts for Men and Women, harmony, etc.
- Please practice with the specific tracks (don't just look them up on YouTube). Imagine you are practicing in choir: think about breaths, endings of words/phrases, rhythms, etc.
- Try to match timing, endings, etc as much as you can with the practice tracks.
- When you come to record, you can sing with any of the tracks you choose (just piano and your part, all the parts, etc).
- Instructions on when to record, what to wear, etc will be sent out early next week.
